Are there building regulations for a wet room?

However, as is the case with any home renovation, there are certain building regulations that need to be considered before the installation goes ahead. Wet room building regulations in the UK are in place to ensure all wet rooms are designed to uphold health, safety and comfort within the home.

Do I need planning permission for a wet room?

If a wet room is being installed as part of a new build, the building regulations that apply will differ to those that apply to a simple bathroom renovation. Although no planning permission is specifically required for the installation of a wet room, designing a wet room for a new build project involves applying for building regulations approval.

Do you need a tanking membrane for a wet room?

But under the new regulation, it is now recommended that domestic locations be waterproofed as well. A wet area is considered to be any wet room, bathroom, shower area, steam room or any other location that is subjected to frequent water contact. This means that it isn't just wet rooms that must have tanking membranes.

Can you put wet room waste under concrete flooring?

Wet room waste can't be fitted underneath solid concrete flooring, but a qualified installer will be able to raise the area to create a suitable space for waste. Depending on how small your bathroom is, you may also need to add a shower screen in to ensure the rest of the bathroom doesn't get wet.

Can a bathroom be converted into a wet room?

Whilst a simple renovation of a bathroom and converting it into a wet room is unlikely to require building regulations approval, this is not the case where significant structural changes are being made.
