How many mounting brackets does a solar panel need?

Each solar panel typically requires 1 or 2 mounting brackets. For instance, a set of 15 solar panels might require between 20 and 30 mounting brackets. Where are solar panel rails sold?

How much gap should be between solar panels?

The gap between the last row of solar panels and the roof's edge should be a minimum of 12 inches or one foot. This ensures the panels are accommodated as they expand and contract during the day.
