

# Can the locker on top of the door be removed

How do you remove a door lock?

To take off the lock's outside trim, use a screwdriver or drill. After you take off the trim, you should be able to get to the lock itself. Take the lock mechanism apart. Depending on the type of lock you have, you may be able to remove the lock cylinder or disconnect the latch or bolt from the door frame. Use a tool to pick locks.

How do you remove a lock cylinder from a door?

Open your door and look at the edge next to the lock cylinder. Here you will see a screw that is roughly in line with the bottom of the lock cylinder. Get a suitable screwdriver and remove the screw and keep somewhere safe.

How do you open a door lock?

Take the lock mechanism apart. Depending on the type of lock you have, you may be able to remove the lock cylinder or disconnect the latch or bolt from the door frame. Use a tool to pick locks. If the lock is a pin tumbler lock, you might be able to open it with a tool for opening locks.

Can a Euro Lock key be removed when a door is locked?

Euro Lock key can only be removed when door is locked. My front door lock has always been difficult to operate. This week it was opened from the outside whilst it still had a key in the barrel on the inside. Since then it is only possible to remove the key from the barrel when the door is locked.

How do you fix a broken door lock?

Now get a pair of mole grips like these Stanley Straight Jaw Locking Plier Mole Grips from B&Q. Place the grips as tightly as possible on the top and bottom of the lock cylinder and push down. Do this a few times until the lock snaps. Now dispose of the lock, fit the new lock and replace the door handles.

How do you remove a barrel from a door lock?

Marie, when you take the central screw (on the edge of the door holding the lock in), when you're withdrawing the barrel, you have to turn the key slightly (to either 20 past or 20 to on the clock) to allow the barrel to come out.
