Renewable electricity here is the sum of hydropower, wind, solar, geothermal, modern biomass and wave and tidal power. In 2016, total energy produced in Samoa is estimated at 129.4 kilo tonnes of oil equivalent. Of the total energy produced, 27.3% was met by biomass, 69.2% by petroleum products while the remaining 3.2% was met by hydropower, solar, wind and other minor

Onshore wind: Potential wind power density (W/m²) is shown in the seven classes used by NREL, measured at a height of 100m. The bar chart shows the distribution of the country's land area in each of these classes compared to the global distribution of wind resources. Areas in the third class or above are considered to be a good wind resource.
