BAKU, AZERBAIJAN (November 15, 2024) - At COP29, countries including UK, Uruguay, Belgium and Sweden committed to increasing the amount of global energy storage sixfold compared to 2022 levels, or 1,500 Gigawatts of capacity by 2030.

Other areas of cooperation include decarbonization, development of green hydrogen in Azerbaijan, electrification of oil and gas platforms, energy innovation zones and energy storage solutions. Britain has also been sharing UK knowledge and experience through the Government-to Government Working Group.

The organisers of the COP29 climate summit -- due to take place in oil-producing Azerbaijan 11-22 November -- have proposed a six-fold increase in global energy storage capacity and the creation of a fair transition fund financed by fossil fuel producers among their ambitions for the event, but have made no mention of any plan to phase out ...
