How do free solar panel schemes work?

'Free' solar panel schemes, also known as rent-a-roof schemes, used to be commonplace a few years ago. These were run by companies eager to cash in on the feed-in tariff (FIT). This guarantees payment in return for electricity generated using renewable technologies, including solar power.

The Feed-in tariff scheme closed to new applicants in 2019 and has been replaced by the much-less-generous Smart Export Guarantee (SEG) scheme, making it much less attractive to businesses to offer free solar schemes. Can you get free solar panels on a roof?

Companies offered to pay to lease your roof from you for 20-25 years and, in exchange, would install and maintain solar PV panels on it.
