Should you buy solar panels from a full-service installer?

If you purchase through a full-service installer, you will likely get a lower price for each panel than buying them individually from a retail store. It's worth noting (as we'll explore further below) that solar modules typically make up less than 20% of the overall cost of a home installation.

How much do monocrystalline solar panels cost?

Monocrystalline solar panels usually cost between \$1 to \$1.50 per watt and are popular among consumers. They are made using single silicon crystals, cut into thin octagonal discs for optimal efficiency. Despite their enhanced efficiency, their higher cost makes them pricier to acquire and install compared to other types.

Why are residential solar panels so expensive?

Since 2010, residential solar panel prices have fallen by roughly 50% while US solar deployment has grown by over 2,000%. The slight rise in residential solar pricing from 2020-2023 is largely attributed to supply chain tangles from the pandemic.

The cost of solar panels depends on the solar panel company you choose. This encompasses the solar equipment system itself, installation costs, and any additional features. Prices may vary between companies, so it's essential to evaluate your options and select the best solar company for your requirements.

On average, solar panels cost \$8.77 per square foot of living space, after factoring in the 30% tax credit. However, the cost per square foot varies based on the size of the home. For example, the post-tax credit cost of solar panels for a 2,500-square-foot home is around \$20,000 for a rate of \$7.96 per square foot.
