

# How much weight can the locker withstand

How wide should a locker be?

Lockers standing on the floor should be positioned so that there is a clear space or aisle at least 900mm wide-but preferably 1000mm - between the locker fronts and the opposing fixture - this could be a parallel run of lockers, or a corridor wall. Always allow clearance for wide-open doors - this varies according to the locker width.

What is the minimum internal clear height of a locker?

Minimum internal clear height of any compartment shall be 200mm. Available standard product range covers all sizes and required overall and minimum compartment heights Material Lockers shall be constructed of sheet steel. Thickness to be not less than 0.5mm to ensure adequate strength to the door, body, frame and shelf.

How much weight can a Cardboard moving box hold?
