How much does energy cost in Ireland?

The cost of all energy imports to Ireland was approximately EUR5.7 billion, down from EUR6.5 billion (revised) in 2013 due mainly to falling oil and, to a lesser extent, gas import prices. Consumption of all fuels fell in 2014 with the exception of peat, renewables and non-renewable wastes.
