Does Japan have a problem with solar power?

A Mainichi Shimbun survey found that of all 47 prefectures in Japan,80% have problems with solar power energy in one way or another. Known as the " sunny land" because of its many fair-weather days, the western Japan prefecture of Okayama is highly suited to solar power generation.

Does Japan have a problem with mega solar farms?

Popular opposition appears to be so strong that a 2021 survey by the Mainichi Shimbun found that 80 percent of Japan's 47 prefectures have problems with mega solar farms. Part of the problem lies in Japan's FIT system. Under the scheme, the Japanese government awards long-term contracts to renewable energy producers.

How much did Japan lose a year based on solar power?

That amounted to more than 10 million yen (about \$89,920) in lost electricity sales revenue per year. The company operates 14 solar power plants across Japan, and power generation efficiency had been declining at an average rate of 1.6% per year as of the end of 2018.

Why is Japan rushing to expand solar power?

*****Japan's rush to expand solar power occurred against the backdrop of the collapse of nuclear power's safety myth,caused by the March 11,2011 meltdowns at Tokyo Electric Power Company Holdings' Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station.

Will Japan stop the megasolar project?
