

## Lithuania solar pecs

Unveiling Lithuania's largest solar park in Moletai, Nordic Solar's milestone investment marks a significant step towards the nation's renewable energy goals. With dignitaries present, including the Danish Ambassador and ...

The new plant, once in operation, will expand the Danish solar company's portfolio in Lithuania to 180 MWp, according to a press statement on Thursday. The project comes on the heels of the Moletai scheme, which was Nordic Solar's first investment in Lithuania and also became the country's largest solar farm.

According to the Ministry of Energy, Lithuania's largest solar park, located in the Moletai area, was inaugurated recently. This solar park, developed by Danish solar developer Nordic Solar, boasts a capacity of 100MW, making ...

Nordic Solar is expanding its presence in Lithuania, building its second solar park in the country. The solar park is situated in the region of Svencionys approx. 80 km north of the capital Vilnius and will have a production capacity of 80 MWp, corresponding to the annual electricity consumption of approx. 26,000 European households.

Being one of the largest solar parks in Lithuania, covering almost 900 hectares, is challenging in terms of design and infrastructure, but we are continuing to work on technical aspects and hope to finalise them in the first half of next year, consequently obtaining construction permits by mid-2025.

Danish solar energy company Nordic Solar is building its largest solar park to date, located in Moletai in eastern Lithuania about 60 km from Vilnius. The new solar park, which is currently under construction, is expected to start producing electricity in the first half of 2024.

The solar park spans across a 150-hectare area, consists of 150,000 photovoltaic modules and will have 100-megawatt (MW) capacity. It was established in a hilly area in Moletai, making it possible to catch sunlight at different time of the day.

The Moletai facility, described by Nordic Solar as the largest solar park in Lithuania to date, is expected to produce enough electricity to power about 28,000 homes when fully commissioned. Since the start of the year, Nordic Solar has launched construction works on two solar parks in Lithuania with a total expected capacity of 180 MWp.
