

How much electricity does Mauritius produce?

The country also has hydroelectric installations capable of producing 60 MW, i.e. 4% of its electricity mix. But this clean energy production capacity remains rather low, given the country's potential. According to the Central Electricity Board (CEB) of Mauritius, the island has an average annual solar radiation of about 6 kWh/m²/day.

What is Mauritius' long term energy strategy?

This is in line with the Government of Mauritius' Long Term Energy Strategy 2009-2025 to increase the share of renewable energy in our energy mix (electricity production, transportation sector and manufacturing) to 35% by, namely, reducing the country's dependence on coal and heavy oil for electricity generation.

Does Mauritius use biomass as an energy source?

Mauritius: Biomass - the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter - is not included in the country's energy production. However, it can be an important energy source in lower-income settings. Mauritius: How much of the country's energy comes from nuclear power? Does Mauritius have a good sanitation system?

The 2014-2018 Strategy Paper has also improved household access to the sanitation network, thus reducing the health risks associated with water-related diseases, with positive effects on people's quality of life. According to the AfDB, in 2018, nearly 100% of Mauritians had access to drinking water and 93.1% to sanitation services.

How much precipitation did Mauritius receive in 2019?

In 2019, Island of Mauritius received 3,972 million cubic metres (Mm³) of precipitation (rainfall), down by 24.4% compared to 5,252 (Mm³) recorded in 2018.
