The Moroccan Agency for Solar Energy (MASEN), a public-private venture, was established to lead the project.

RABAT, July 10 (Reuters) - Morocco's renewable energy agency Masen said on Monday six consortiums pre-qualified to build a 400-megawatt solar plant in the Atlas mountains, dubbed Noor Midelt II.

Will Morocco build a solar power station in Ouarzazate?

The Moroccan Agency for Solar Energy invited expressions of interest in the design, construction, operation, maintenance and financing of the first of the five planned solar power stations, the 500 MW complex in the southern town of Ouarzazate, that includes both PV and CSP. Construction officially began on 10 May 2013.

What percentage of Morocco's electricity is renewable?

In 2022, renewables represented 18% of total electricity production in the country, while coal accounted for 72%, according to official figures. By March 2023, renewable energy represented 40% of the country's installed capacity as Morocco plans to increase that share to 52% by 2030. Our Standards: The Thomson Reuters Trust Principles.

Does Morocco have a power cable link to Europe?

Morocco has a power cable link to Europe, the Spain-Morocco interconnection, rated at 900 MW when going from Spain to Morocco and 600 MW when going from Morocco to Spain. This is the first electric interconnection built between Africa and Europe.
