Where are solar panels not ideally suited?

The following is a list of 7 situations where solar panels may not be ideally suited. For a solar panel to generate the most power, it should ideally be facing true south.

Are solar panels right for You?

Solar panels are best for people who live in good solar states with solar-friendly policies, like net metering and solar incentive programs. Homes with south-facing roofs and lots of unshaded space are also ideal for solar. Homeowners with high electricity bills are among those who can benefit the most from going solar.

Your installers will usually need to erect scaffolding to install solar panels on your roof. Once this is up, solar panels can be installed in a day or two. The inverter will usually be fitted in either a loft or garage. This converts the DC your panels produce to AC that you can use in your home.
