

The application process follows nine steps to ensure a smooth and efficient submission and approval of solar panel installation. As of July 23, 2024, the scheme has received 1.28 crore registrations and 14.84 lakh applications, supported by 6,552 registered vendors across the country .

PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana is a government scheme that aims to provide free electricity to households in India. The scheme was launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on February 15, 2024. Under the scheme, households will be provided with a subsidy to install solar panels on their roofs.

Hon"ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi launched the National Portal for Rooftop Solar on 30/07/2022. Shri R. K. Singh, Union Minister for Power and NRE and Shri Krishan Pal Gurjar, MoS, Power and Heavy Industries were present.

The Prime Minister had launched the scheme on 13th February, 2024. The major highlights of the scheme include: Central Financial Assistance (CFA) for Residential Rooftop Solar. The scheme provides a CFA of 60% of system cost for 2 kW systems and 40% of additional system cost for systems between 2 to 3 kW capacity. The CFA will be capped at 3 kW.

The Rooftop Solar Yojana, or the PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana, aims to provide 300 units of free electricity every month to light up one crore households. The objective of this scheme is to reduce the electricity costs of the house by installing rooftop solar panels and using solar energy.

The scheme was later renamed to PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana and launched on February 13, 2024, with a total allocation of Rs. 75,021 crore (~US\$ 9 billion). This ambitious project aims to install solar panels on one crore houses to generate electricity from solar energy.
