Where is Saint Pierre located?

Where is Saint Pierre and Miquelon?

Saint Pierre and Miquelon is situated south of Newfoundland in the Gulf of Saint Lawrence in the North Atlantic Ocean. Its distance north-south from Newfoundland is 60 kilometres (32 nmi). The islands are even closer to the long Burin Peninsula, which is situated just 25 kilometres (13 nmi) to the east.

What was the purpose of Saint Pierre & Miquelon?

Saint-Pierre was an outpost used to transport alcohol from Canada to the United States during Prohibition. [4] Until 1945, there existed a third commune in Saint Pierre and Miquelon: L'Î le-aux-Marins. The commune of L'Î le-aux-Marins was annexed by the commune of Saint-Pierre in 1945.

Is there a police station in Saint Pierre & Miquelon?

The French Navy has maintained a patrol boat, the ex-trawler Fulmar, in the region since 1997. Law enforcement in Saint Pierre and Miquelon is the responsibility of a branch of the French Gendarmerie Nationale; there are two police stations in the archipelago.

What was the highlight of St Pierre & Miquelon?

For me, the highlight of St. Pierre and Miquelon was visiting Île aux Marins-- Sailors' Island, sometimes called Pioneers' Island. This small island off the coast of St. Pierre was a commune for 300 years until it was annexed by St. Pierre in 1945. There was no electricity until 1963!
