## Solar plus storage systems Mozambique

Independent power producer (IPP) Globeleq has brought a 19MWp solar PV, 2MW/7MWh energy storage plant in Mozambique into commercial operation. The Cuamba Solar plant is Globeleq's first greenfield project in Mozambique, its first combined solar and storage facility in its operational portfolio, and the first in the country, and went into ...

Mozambique"s Ministry of Mineral Resources and Energy has kicked off a tender for the development of decentralized solar and battery storage systems in the provinces of Nampula, Zambézia and Sofala, all located along the eastern coast of Mozambique, and the province of Gaza in the south.

The Ministry of Mineral Resources and Energy of Mozambique has received funds for a tender programme to procure a decentralised utility solar photovoltaic (PV) plus battery energy storage system project. DEADLINE: 13 September 2024 at 12pm. The tender programme will be executed under the Energy Regulatory Authority of Mozambique (ARERE).

The project is the first IPP in Mozambique to integrate a utility scale energy storage system and includes an upgrade to the existing Cuamba substation. Electricity will be sold through a 25-year power purchase ...

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The Energy Regulatory Authority is seeking two qualified independent power producers to develop, finance, build, own, operate and transfer two lots of solar-plus-storage projects in the provinces of Nampula, Zambézia and Sofala, all located along the eastern coast of Mozambique, and the province of Gaza in the south.

Though the project is the first large-scale solar-plus-storage project in Mozambique, a larger, 300MW project recently secured a land agreement for a 950 hectare area a few months after its developer Ncondezi Energy launched a feasibility study into it.

Globeleq, a London-based independent power producer, said in a press release this week that it started commercial operations on Sept. 12 at its 19 MWp Cuamba solar PV and 7 MWh energy storage...
