A dramatic change from the chaotic period of the Five Dynasties and the Ten Kingdoms (907-60) that preceded it, the Song dynasty was a time of attempted reforms, scholarly studies and artistic progress, marked by authentication of the Confucian literary canon and systematic development and promotion of Neo-Confucianism.

How did the Song dynasty influence China?

Under the Song dynasty iron production in 1078 was double that of England in the early industrial revolution in the late 18th century. Chinese ships had watertight compartments, pivoting sails and compasses. Large sailing ships had six masts, four decks and were capable of carrying a 1000 men.
