

(Togo First) - Togo just inked two solar energy agreements with the RELP association and Chinese company HAIER. The deals were sealed on December 5, during the first West African Energy Cooperation Summit in Lomé.

Now one of the largest solar PV IPP plants in West Africa, the power plant is located 267kms from Togo's capital, Lomé, and has a planned production of nearly 90,255MWh of power a year. This will supply power to about 158,333 households a year.

The company selected is expected to build the energy infrastructure over a period of between twelve and sixteen months. Together with an evacuation line, the solar park will provide electricity to at least 60 localities in the Savanes region.

A global infrastructure investor has signed a 25-year concession agreement with Togo and a French multinational electric utility company for the design, construction, financing and operation of a 64MWp solar PV power plant.

The largest solar photovoltaic plant in West Africa is now operational. The facility with a capacity of 50 MWp is located in Blitta, in the Central Region of Togo. The solar power plant is owned by the Emirati independent power producer (IPP) Amea Power.
