How does Trinidad and Tobago's energy sector affect economic growth?

The performance of Trinidad and Tobago's energy sector has far-reaching implications for the country's macroeconomic indicators and fundamentals such as fiscal stability, export earnings, foreign exchange reserves and overall economic growth.

What is the energy policy of Trinidad and Tobago?

The Government of Trinidad and Tobago is currently developing a national energy policy green paper that recognises renewable energy's (RE) combined with energy efficiency (EE) and utilisation of compressed natural gas in the transportation sector, inter-alia, as important strategies for the promotion of sustainable development of the nation.

Will Trinidad & Tobago bring gas from Loran field?

Trinidad and Tobago also expects to resume negotiations to bring gas from the Loran field for processing. Crude oil exports averaged 1,660,000 barrels per month between January 2022 and April 2023.

Does Trinidad & Tobago have a GDP growth rate?

Prior to the pandemic, real GDP growth in Trinidad and Tobago has been subdued with an annual average of -0.9% between 2013 and 2019. The estimated growth in 2022 and 2023 represents a continued, albeit partial recovery of the base effect lost during the pandemic (2020-21).
