

How much energy does Malawi use?

Malawi relies on biomass energy for cooking and heating, with wood fuel and charcoal accounting for approximately 86% of the country's total energy consumption compared to 10% for oil products, 3% for electricity and 1% for coal.

How can Malawi diversify its energy mix?

The government of Malawi has recognized this challenge and has made efforts to diversify the country's electricity mix by promoting the use of renewable energy sources. Currently, JCM solar is feeding 80MW into the grid and Serengeti is feeding in 21MW. EGENCO also supplies 1.3 MW from solar, to Chizumulu and Likoma Islands.

Malawi has no significant reserves of crude oil or natural gas, and thus relies on imports to meet its energy needs. In all imported oil products, Petrol contributes 45% of the imported oil products, which is the highest compared to aviation fuels which is the lowest.

How much coal does Malawi have?

Malawi has coal reserves estimated at 22 billion tons. Coal can also be imported from neighboring Mozambique, via railroad. In 2014, Malawi decided to go ahead with plans to build Kammwamba Thermal Power Station, a planned 1,000 megawatts (1,300,000 hp), coal-fired power station in Neno District.
