

What to put in the locker to prevent moisture

How can I protect my storage unit from moisture?

To protect your storage unit from moisture, choose a high-quality, moisture-resistant unit. This will help you avoid the additional worries and stress that come with dealing with moisture damage.

How do you keep a storage unit dry?

The clay effectively absorbs the moisture in the air and prevents the growth of mold and mildew. Kitty litter may need to be changed every several weeks to maintain optimum freshness.

To ensure a moisture-resistant and mold-free storage unit, it is highly recommended that you take the following steps. Measuring the humidity levels inside your storage unit regularly is important. Indoor humidity should never exceed 50%.
