How to install solar panels?

Make space for the solar panel accessories (solar inverter, cables and solar batteries, if desired), for instance in a plant room 4. Plan a day for installation 5. Erect the scaffolding (this can be done by your supplier or by a company you organise) 6. The solar panel mounts will be installed 7. The professionals will install the solar panels 8.

Do I need planning permission for solar panels?

For more information, contact your local planning authority - your local council - for advice about planning permission for solar panels. If you are a leaseholder, you'll also need the permission of the freeholder to install solar panels. Is my home suitable for solar PV panels?

Should you buy a solar PV system for your home?

Well-chosen solar panels can provide a reliable source of renewable electricity for decades, helping to slash your electricity bills and cut your carbon footprint. But buying an inappropriate solar PV system for your home could leave you out of pocket.

How do I choose a solar PV company?

Check local planning regulations to make sure you're allowed to install a solar PV system (see above). Check that the solar PV company is MCS certified and a member of the Renewable Energy Consumer Code (RECC). Don't accept a price over the phone before the firm has visited. Get an Energy Performance Certificate for your home.

Do you need a solar panel system to be energy independent?

If you want to be fully energy independent, you will need more panels and a solar battery big enough to store the excess energy you generate. As long as you install a solar panel system powerful enough to cover your household's energy usage, you can rely on solar electricity for all your energy needs.
