The United States African Development Foundation (USADF) has granted Community Energy Malawi (CEM) a total of MK429,120,122 to enhance energy access in Chisenga village, Mchinji. The funds will be used to construct a 60KW solar mini-grid aimed at boosting economic productivity and improving the livelihoods of residents.

In his speech, project funders GEAPP Vice-President for Africa, Joseph Nganga, described the project as a game-changer to the Malawi energy sector. "Energy lies at the heart of development. It is an enabler that powers industries. Energy is not just about turning on the lights. It is about powering dreams.

Malawi is on the cusp of a transformative era in its energy sector, poised to make significant strides in electrification, sustainable development and poverty alleviation. The country boasts vast untapped potential in renewable energy sources such as hydroelectric, solar and geothermal resources.

Their goal is to switch not less than 24,000 consumers to gas within the next 24 months, a significant step towards reducing deforestation and promoting sustainable energy use in Malawi. The support from GETF has been instrumental in positioning 265 Energy Limited as a leader in the country's energy transition.

International cooperation, through a Fossil Fuel Non-Proliferation Treaty, can unlock the finance and technology essential for Malawi and other African nations to unleash their renewable energy potential, with cascading effects for the country's development and resilience.
